

Newton Abbot Collective Machinery Sale on Saturday 23rd March 2024

Spring like warm weather created a large crowd of prospective purchasers who had gathered at Rendells' first machinery sale of 2024. A large range of items on offer attracted interest from all over the Southwest with live and online bidding via the platform, MartEye.

Racing away to the top call of the day was a Hitachi FB100 wheel digger with 4 buckets selling for £14,000 to a local purchaser. The star of the show was the Massey Ferguson 240 tractor, with only 44 hours on the clock, barn stored being an ex Ministry of Defence vehicle which attracted keen interest and finally sold for £10,000.



A John Deere 570 round baler received good interest with bidding topping out at £3000, a Vicon Fanex turner sold to £2300 with strong interest in the Farmall M tractor, locally consigned selling for £2000.

Trailers were keenly sort after with a 2T Bateson tipping trailer realising £1500 with a car/plant trailer racing away to the same money and an Ifor Williams car trailer selling to £1150.
