


Terms of Sale

Sellers Commission	Commission will be charged according to the hammer price achieved being: 10% plus VAT up to £1,000 and then 6% plus VAT for the amount over £1,000 of the hammer price for each individual lot
Minimum Commission	A minimum commission of £2 plus VAT will be charged on each lot
Closing Date for 	Details of entries including 6 photos (minimum) to be received by Friday 26 th April 2024 at the latest for sufficient advertising and uploading and notification to buyers.
Closing Date for Advertising	Details of entries to be received no later than Friday 26 th April 2024 for sufficient advertising in the paper, online & social media.
Reserve Price	All reserves to be given in writing no later than 17:00pm Friday 3 rd May 2024
Delivery of Items	Items can only be delivered to the sale premises between Thursday 2 nd May from 9am to 5:00pm and on Friday 3 rd May 9:00am – 5:00pm only. **No items accepted on sale day** No Wheels/Rims/Tyres accepted
Sold/Unsold Lots	To be removed by 5pm on Sunday 5 th May 2024. Any lots remaining in the sale field after Monday 6 th May 2024 will be disposed of and the auctioneers, Rendells will charge the purchaser/vendor for the costs incurred.
Registration Books	Registration Books or certificates of non-registration should be handed to the auctioneers when machines are brought in.
All Lots Entered for Sale	Must be offered for sale by Auction, any post-auction private transactions whilst the lots are in the sale park must go through the auctioneer's book.
Lease or Hire Purchase	No items on lease or hire purchase will be accepted for sale unless consent in writing is obtained from the leasing or hire purchase company.
Warranties	Vendors of machinery who wish to give warranties or guarantees are requested to enter full details on the entry form. Unless any warranty is given all lots are sold as seen
Electrical Items	Under the Consumer Protection Act 1987, and The Low Voltage Electrical Equipment (Safety) Regulations 1994 all electrical goods and appliances offered for sale at Auction must have been tested for safety by a properly qualified electrician. Every electrical appliance must display a current in date safety inspection label/sticker. The auctioneers will refuse to accept any electrical items which have not passed the safety test. These requirements also apply to electric motors on farm machinery and equipment
Full Conditions	Full conditions of sale are available from the auctioneers, all vendors shall be deemed to have a full knowledge of same and are therefore advised to obtain a copy from the auctioneers. All lots are accepted at the vendors risk and if not sold shall continue to be held by the auctioneers at the vendors risk. Goods remain on the sale ground at the purchaser's risk after the fall of the hammer. The auctioneer accepts no liability for any goods whilst on the sale ground, nor shall the auctioneers be under any liability to notify vendors of lots if not sold
