

Sale Report for the Reduction Sale for Messrs W.R. Heath & Sons at Homefield Park Farm, Sherford, Kingsbridge

The sale arose from David, Michael and Angela Heath's decision to cut back their farming enterprises and the sale attracted good crowds who also enjoyed the unsurpassed view from the sale field down across the Kingsbridge estuary to Salcombe and beyond.

Bidding was strong both from purchasers in the sale field as well as online bidding and the top call for Messrs Heath's machinery was £13,700 for a New Holland TS115 Tractor (2000) sold to a buyer from Newton Abbot, £13,500 for a Massey Ferguson 6290 power control Tractor (2002) which sold to a buyer from Somerset, £13,000 for a Kverneland 5 Furrow Reversible Plough (2014) which sold for £13,000 to a buyer from Cornwall, £9,000 for a Ford County 6600-Four Tractor c/w Browns High Master Front Loader (1978) which sold to a buyer from Salcombe.

Other notable prices included £3,000 for a Manitou BF Forklift (1985), £2,600 for a Twose set of folding hydraulic Rollers, £2,200 for a Griffiths 10T double axle Tipping Trailer, £2,100 for a New Holland 940 Conventional Baler with Bale Accumulator, £1,800 for a Dowdeswell Speed Harrow, £1,700 for a Kverneland 4 Furrow Reversible Plough, £1,100 for Leyland 245 Tractor (1974), £1,000 for a Commer Diesel Lorry with hydraulic tipping base (1968).

The introduced machinery section the top call was £12,000 for a Case MX120 Tractor (1997), £3,500 for a Ford 7700 2WD Tractor (1976) with 8210 engine and gearbox and £1,400 for a Kuhn 2.5 Power Harrow.
